

# Neighbourhood Planning Worksheet 4

### Community Engagement and Involvement

Effective community engagement and involvement is essential right from the beginning of the process. Good community engagement will create a well-informed plan and a sense of ownership, A falure to do so may increase the risk of an adverse outcome at the referendum stage.


