Letter from Fr Chris

We had nine events during Easter, one of which was a fundraising event, which raised £750 for supporting refugees in the Ukraine, via the Diocese of Europe. It was a wonderful morning and I must thank the wardens and many others for all their hard work. So much raised in only two hours. I pray that peace can be found soon, though I worry that each month things seem to be getting worse, many lives lost and many homeless.

Funds raised will support humanitarian work both in Ukraine (where there is an Anglican chaplaincy in Kyiv) and with refugees fleeing into neighbouring countries.

In May we continue the Gospel of John, chapter 13 v 34 Jesus gives the disciples and the world a new commandment 34, I give you a new commandment, that you love one another. Just as I have loved you, you also should love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." John 13v34 NRSV

These two verses remind us all, that we must take care to think before we react and how we all can be blinded by our own views. I ask you to spend some time in the month of May, in prayer and lamentation on how important it is to remember that we should love one another and stand with those who are persecuted.

A prayer for the Ukraine:

God of peace and justice,
we pray for the people of Ukraine today.
We pray for peace and the laying down of weapons.
We pray for all those who fear for tomorrow
that your Spirit of comfort would draw near to them.
We pray for those with power over war or peace,
for wisdom, discernment and compassion
to guide their decisions.
Above all, we pray for all your precious children,
at risk and in fear,
that you would hold and protect them.
We pray in the name of Jesus, the Prince of Peace.

<u>Queens' Platinum Jubilee - Sunday, 5th June</u> Burghwallis Playing Field

Plans are moving on apace for the day of celebration, music, film, arts and more to celebrate the Jubilee and at the same time raise funds for Ukraine refugees in the UK. Imagine sitting in the mid-summer sunshine, enjoying a picnic, as you experience one of the most exciting and contemporary Jubilee events in the area. There will be live music, stalls, art installations, workshops, activities, entertainment, a huge public picnic (bring your own rugs, chairs etc) and two outdoor movies! All of this is free (apart from the movies, for which tickets will be on sale in advance.)

The gates open at 1 p.m., when you can choose your picnic spot and set yourself out to enjoy the occasion. The afternoon film is Paddington - picking up on the village connection with Shirley Clarkson, of Paddington Bear fame - and children are invited to bring along their favourite teddy bear and enjoy the various bear-themed activities as well as other creative activities around the park. The evening film is Mary Poppins and will start around 6 p.m., with access to the screen area from 5 p.m.

Throughout the day, you can explore and walk through the woodland area between the Playing Field and the pub car park to find a secret and magical area full of surprises and treats, and, of course, from there you have access to the pub, where there will be live music, stalls and food going on into the evening.

There will be various installations and opportunities to support Ukrainian families, our peace and wish tree, post box and art installations will be available all day in the woodland area for you to leave messages and letters of hope.

In the evening, the fairy lights will be switched on, your lanterns can be lit in a vigil for peace, and people can leave in silence as we reflect on those families in the Ukraine and elsewhere in the world currently affected by the ongoing tragic situation.

All of this is **FREE**, though we do ask for a voluntary donation of £5 per person if you can manage it. Entry to the screen area is by pre-booked ticket only, and all information about films and prices will be announced shortly, via a specially created website. www.burghwallisjubilee.com.
